#### **METHODOLOGY NOTE**

ComRes interviewed 200 easyJet pilots on permanent contracts and 100 pilots employed by easyJet as "flexicrew" by telephone between 1st and 7th March 2013. The sample was drawn from BALPA's membership. ComRes is a member of the British Polling Council and abides by its rules.
