

# BBC BREAKFAST Office workers and lunch-breaks

### **METHODOLOGY NOTE**

ComRes interviewed 591 full-time or part-time workers, who spend most of their working hours in an office environment by telephone from 11<sup>th</sup> to 13<sup>th</sup> January, 18<sup>th</sup> to 20<sup>th</sup> January and 25<sup>th</sup> to 27<sup>th</sup> January 2013, over three waves of the telephone omnibus. Respondents were drawn from a sample that was weighted to be demographically representative of all British adults. ComRes is a member of the British Polling Council and abides by its rules.

All press releases or other publications must be checked with ComRes before use. ComRes requires 48 hours to check a press release unless otherwise agreed.
