

BBC Points West – ‘When I Get Older’ Poll

METHODOLOGY NOTE

ComRes interviewed 1,000 adults from the Points West region (Bristol, Bath & North East Somerset, North Somerset, South Gloucestershire, Somerset, Gloucestershire, Wiltshire, North Dorset) aged 30-65 by telephone between 20th February and 5th March. Data were weighted to be representative of all adults aged 30-65 living in the region. ComRes is a member of the British Polling Council and abides by its rules.
