METHODOLOGY NOTE

ComRes interviewed 500 adults living in the South Yorkshire Police Force area by telephone from 5th to 10th October. Data were weighted to be demographically representative of all of adults aged 18+ living in the South Yorkshire Police Force area. ComRes is a member of the British Polling Council and abides by its rules.
