METHODOLOGY NOTE

ComRes interviewed 1,005 18-35 year olds in Great Britain online from 24th to 26th October 2012. Data were weighted to be representative of all GB adults aged 18-35. ComRes is a member of the British Polling Council and abides by its rules.

Charity trustees are people who form the governing body or 'board' of a charity. They are the people with ultimate responsibility for directing the business of the charity. Most trustees are volunteers, and receive out-of-pocket expenses. Trustees work together to make the decisions about the charity's finances, activities and plans for the future. Trustees give leadership and direction, and may employ staff. They need to prepare for and attend trustee meetings. A trustee might learn new skills, meet people who have a passion for a particular cause or issue, and feel that they are making a difference through the work of a charity.
