#### **METHODOLOGY NOTE**

ComRes interviewed 2,039 GB adults online between 21st and 23rd March 2014. The data in the tables excludes those respondents who say that raised £10,000 or more running for charity in the past 12 months (total: 2,036). Data were weighted to be representative of all GB adults aged 18+. ComRes is a member of the British Polling Council and abides by its rules.
