#### METHODOLOGY NOTE

ComRes interviewed 1,080 adults aged 18+ who work from GB online between 7<sup>th</sup> and 9<sup>th</sup> June 2013. Data were weighted to be representative of all adults aged 18+ in GB. ComRes is a member of the British Polling Council and abides by its rules.


