#### **METHODOLOGY NOTE**

ComRes interviewed 1,001 adults living in the council areas of the Scottish Borders and Dumfries & Galloway by telephone between 9<sup>th</sup> and 15<sup>th</sup> June 2014. Data were weighted to be representative of all adults aged 16+ from the region. ComRes is a member of the British Polling Council and abides by its rules.
