ComRes interviewed 1,000 adults living in the council areas of the Scottish Borders and Dumfries & Galloway by telephone between 3rd and 9th September 2014. Data were weighted to be representative of all adults aged 16+ from the region. ComRes is a member of the British Polling Council and abides by its rules.
