

Leonard Cheshire Disability – Accessible Housing

METHODOLOGY NOTE

ComRes interviewed 2,006 GB adults aged 18+ online between the 4th and 6th June 2014; including 238 who self-identified as having a mobility impairment. Data were weighted to be representative of all GB adults aged 18+. ComRes is a member of the British Polling Council and abides by its rules.
