METHODOLOGY NOTE

ComRes interviewed 4,207 UK adults aged 18+ (including 1,108 aged 18-35) online between 29th January and 2nd February 2014. Data were weighted to be representative of all UK adults aged 18-25, 26-35, 36-45, 46-55, 56+ by gender and region. ComRes is a member of the British Polling Council and abides by its rules.
