METHODOLOGY NOTE

ComRes interviewed 1,502 adults in areas of England where local election are taking place on 2nd May. Interviews were done online between 24th and 28th April 2013. Data were weighted to be demographically representative of all GB adults. ComRes is a member of the British Polling Council and abides by its rules.
