Methodology

Conducted by postal self-completion questionnaire between 14 June and 8 July 2004 among MPs on the CommunicateResearch Parliamentary Panel. 150 MPs participated (84 Labour, 39 Conservative and 27 from the smaller parties). Data may not add up to 100% due to rounding

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
