

Your Legal Friend – Road Traffic Accidents

METHODOLOGY NOTE

ComRes interviewed online 1,003 UK drivers who have been involved in one or more road traffic accidents (RTAs) in the past 5 years between the 4th – 9th October 2013. ComRes is a member of the British Polling Council and abides by its rules.

All press releases or other publications must be checked with ComRes before use. ComRes requires 48 hours to check a press release unless otherwise agreed.
