#### METHODOLOGY NOTE

ComRes interviewed 2,004 GB adults online between 13<sup>th</sup> and 14<sup>th</sup> January 2016. Data were weighted to be representative of all GB adults aged 18+. ComRes is a member of the British Polling Council and abides by its rules.
