

## BBC RADIO 5 LIVE – MENTAL HEALTH AND THE WORKPLACE

Methodology: ComRes interviewed 1,104 GB adults who work full or part time online between 26<sup>th</sup> and 27<sup>th</sup> April 2017. Overall data, from which this sample was drawn, were weighted to be demographically representative of all GB adults by age, gender, region and socio-economic grade. ComRes is a member of the British Polling Council and abides by its rules.
