

BE REASONABLE – SURVEY OF SCOTTISH ADULTS

Methodology: ComRes interviewed 1,010 Scottish adults online between 21st September and 2nd October 2017. Data were weighted to be demographically representative of all Scottish adults aged 18+. ComRes is a member of the British Polling Council and abides by its rules.
