## METHODOLOGY NOTE

ComRes interviewed 152 MPs online and by self-completion paper questionnaire between 9<sup>th</sup> June and 1<sup>st</sup> August 2015. Data were weighted by party and region to be representative of the whole House of Commons. ComRes is a member of the British Polling Council and abides by its rules.
