Methodology: Savanta ComRes interviewed 501 residents of Greater London who will be eligible to vote in the May 2020 mayoral elections\* from the 27th January to 14th February 2020. Data were weighted to be demographically representative of Greater London by age, gender, social grade and sub-region.
