Methodology: ComRes interviewed 2,008 British adults (aged 18+) between 28th and 29th November 2018. Data were weighted to be demographically representative of all British adults by gender, age, region and socio-economic grade. ComRes is a member of the British Polling Council and abides by its rules.
