#### **METHODOLOGY NOTE**

ComRes interviewed 2,057 British adults online between 31<sup>st</sup> March and 1<sup>st</sup> April 2015. Data were weighted to be representative of all GB adults aged 18+. ComRes is a member of the British Polling Council and abides by its rules.
