METHODOLOGY NOTE

ComRes interviewed 502 young people aged between 14 and 22 in Great Britain online between the 29th September and 7th October 2014. Data were weighted to be representative of all young people in Britain aged between 14 and 22 by age, gender and region. ComRes is a member of the British Polling Council and abides by its rules.
