

# RCGP Survey of GPs in Devolved Nations, April 2016 (Scotland Data Only)

## METHODOLOGY NOTE

ComRes interviewed 350 General Practitioners online between 30<sup>th</sup> March and 19<sup>th</sup> April 2016. The sample of respondents included 150 GPs in Scotland and 100 in each of Wales and Northern Ireland.
