METHODOLOGY NOTE

ComRes interviewed 1,018 British women aged 18–49 online between 11th and 15th November 2015. Data were weighted by age, socio-economic grade and region to be representative of all GB women. ComRes is a member of the British Polling Council and abides by its rules.
