

## Brexit Express – April 2019

ComRes interviewed 1,061 GB adults online on 16 April 2019. Data were weighted to be demographically representative of all GB adults by age, gender and region. Voting intention questions were also weighted by past vote recall and likelihood to vote. Additional questions relating to the EU were weighted by 2016 EU Referendum results.
