

Remain United, Election Poll – 9 December 2019

Methodology: Savanta ComRes interviewed 6,073 British adults online from the 6th to 8th December 2019. Data were weighted to be demographically representative of all GB adults. All questions were also weighted by 2017 past vote recall and EU Referendum past vote. Voting Intention is also weighted by likelihood to vote.
