METHODOLOGY

Methodology: ComRes interviewed 6,097 British adults online from the 30th October – 5th November 2019. Data were weighted to be demographically representative of all GB adults. All questions were also weighted by 2017 past vote recall and EU Referendum past vote. Voting Intention is also weighted by likelihood to vote.
