

# Independent Age – Loneliness Poll

#### METHODOLOGY NOTE

ComRes interviewed 1,014 British adults aged 18+ by telephone between the 27<sup>th</sup> and 31<sup>st</sup> October 2016. Data were weighted to be nationally representative of all British adults aged 18+. ComRes is a member of the British Polling Council and abides by its rules.
