Methodology: ComRes interviewed 155 MPs online or by self-completion paper survey between 14<sup>th</sup> November and 11<sup>th</sup> December 2017. Data were weighted by party and region to be representative of the House of Commons. ComRes is a member of the British Polling Council and abides by its rules.
