

# LEONARD CHESHIRE DISABILITY: SURVEY OF DISABLED ADULTS: SOCIAL CARE SECTION

Methodology: ComRes interviewed 1,119 disabled adults in GB, aged between 18 and 65, from 15th June to 10th July 2017. Data were weighted by gender and region to be nationally representative of disabled adults of working age in the UK. Data were also weighted to the 2016 age distribution in order to make direct comparisons.

In 2016 ComRes interviewed 1,032 disabled adults in GB, aged between 18 and 65, from 28th April to 10th May 2016. Data were weighted by gender and region to be representative of disabled adults of working age in GB.
