

# LEONARD CHESHIRE DISABILITY SURVEY: EMPLOYMENT SECTION

ComRes interviewed 1,647 disabled adults in the UK aged between 18 and 65 years old between from June 29th to July 26th 2018. Data were weighted to be nationally representative of this audience by age, gender and UK region. ComRes is a member of the British Polling Council and abides by its rules.


