METHODOLOGY NOTE

ComRes interviewed 1,120 adults aged 18+ living in Benghazi between 23rd June and 3rd July 2016. Interviews were conducted face-to-face, and by telephone in the hard to reach areas of the city. Quotas were set by Mahallah and gender, with a good spread by age and education level. ComRes is a member of the British Polling Council and abides by its rules.
