

## Centre for Cities, City Region Research: Cambridgeshire and Peterborough – April 2021

*Methodology: Savanta ComRes interviewed 261 residents of Cambridgeshire and Peterborough aged 18+ between 26th February and 16th March 2021. Data were weighted to be demographically representative of Cambridgeshire and Peterborough by age, gender, sub-region and social grade. Savanta ComRes is a member of the British Polling Council and abides by its rules.*
