Methodology: Methodology: Savanta ComRes interviewed 606 residents of Greater London aged 18+ between 26th February and 16th March 2021. Data were weighted to be demographically representative of Greater London by age, gender, sub-region and social grade. Savanta ComRes is a member of the British Polling Council and abides by its rules.

The previous wave of this research was conducted among 501 London residents between 27th January and 14th February 2020.
