## METHODOLOGY NOTE

ComRes interviewed 504 GPs online between the 23<sup>rd</sup> and 27<sup>th</sup> October 2015. Quotas were set to ensure a representative spread of GPs across the former SHA regions of England, Scotland, Wales and Northern Ireland. ComRes is a member of the British Polling Council and abides by its rules.
