METHODOLOGY NOTE

ComRes interviewed 995 UK parents of children aged 18 or under online between 14nd and 18th January 2015. A sample of 995 parents was taken from a survey of 2000 GB adults. Data were weighted to be representative of all GB adults aged 18+. ComRes is a member of the British Polling Council and abides by its rules.
