



## THE SUN – POLL OF 2015 UKIP VOTERS

**Methodology:** ComRes surveyed 527 British adults who voted for UKIP candidates at the last General Election, on 2<sup>nd</sup> June 2017\*. The survey was conducted online from a nationally representative sample. Results are representative of the demographic profile of UKIP voters at GE2015 by age and gender. ComRes is a member of the British Polling Council and abides by its rules.

*\*Please note, fieldwork took place before the London Terror Attacks on Saturday 3<sup>rd</sup> June 2017.*
