METHODOLOGY NOTE

ComRes interviewed 1,013 British parents with children aged 18 and under online between the 24th and 29th August 2016. Data were weighted to be nationally representative of all British adults aged 18+. ComRes is a member of the British Polling Council and abides by its rules.
