

Timewise: Flexible Working Survey

Methodology: ComRes interviewed 3,001 UK adults online between 13th and 26th June 2017. Respondents were surveyed from the following groups:

- 501 not working but wanting to work
- 1,250 employed full-time
- 750 employed part-time
- 500 self-employed

Data for full-time and part-time workers are weighted to be representative of these groups. Other data are unweighted.
