#### **METHODOLOGY NOTE**

ComRes interviewed 516 parents with children aged 18 and under online between 10th August and 11th August 2016. Overall data were weighted to be representative of all GB adults aged 18+. ComRes is a member of the British Polling Council and abides by its rules.
